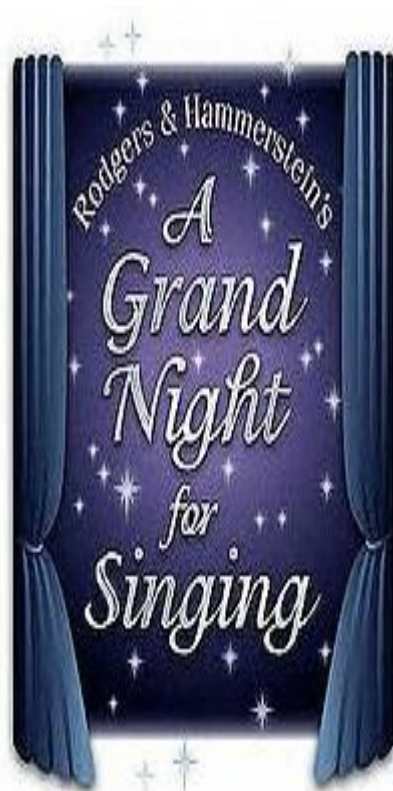

as possible so if you haven't already done so, please let him have your e-mail address.

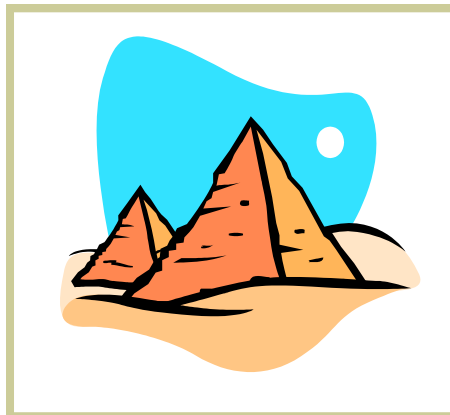
If anyone has any other ideas for nights out or things we can do through the summer to keep us in touch with one another then please let Neil. If you are willing to organise something then let him know that too.
